ArtWork: No hidden sponsors, no soft soap

Some artistic highlights of 2012

For all the general doom and gloom in the country the independent arts scene in Scotland the North is surprisingly buoyant. New galleries spring up in the most unlikely places and, alas, some long established ones close.

In March of 2012 the Collins Gallery in Glasgow, part of the University of Strathclyde for some 40 years, will mount its last exhibition. Fittingly this will be of the work of George Wyllie – works on paper and material from his home – since the University has a large archive of his work.

Wyllie's work is being celebrated in a number of different locations during the year with a festival bearing his name leading up to a big exhibition of his work in the Mitchell Library, Glasgow next November.

The Olympics will feature in an enterprising exhibition at the City Art Centre in Edinburgh. 'The Human Race,' courtesy of the Royal College of Surgeons, takes as its theme the movement of the human body. Also on at the centre during

the year will be The Scottish Artist and the Garden and a drawing show entitled A Parliament of Lines.

In November there will be retrospective of the work of the late Wilhelmina Barns-Graham.

The Watermill in Aberfeldy is celebrating the centenary of the artist's birth in St Andrews (on June 8, 2012) with an exhibition of late prints (with some works for sale) and paintings. The show, which opens in May, is being mounted in conjunction with the Barns-Graham Charitable Trust.

The Olympic theme has been taken up by the Moray Art Centre at Findhorn. With the working title The Olympic Impulse they are showing a classical Greek art and 19th century works with links to Lord Elgin and the marbles of that ilk.

The Olympic Impulse is at the centre from June through till September.

In nearby Inverness the Castle Gallery has Jonathan Shearer with a new take on a classic Scottish

theme – Highland stags not so much at bay as larger than life in living watercolour. The following month, April, sees an exhibition of the work of Ian McWhinnie from Glasgow.

Farther north, at Brown's Gallery in Tain, David Eustace and Craig Mackay are promising a photographic show that would amply justify the few extra miles' journey to reach this northern outpost.

Meanwhile the Strathearn Gallery in Crieff is looking forward to mounting another exhibition of the work of Chris Bushe. This is scheduled to open in July.

Back in the Central Belt, January provides the annual opportunity to view the collection of Turner watercolours and prints held by the National Galleries of Scotland. The 38 watercolours formed part of the Henry Vaughan Bequest to the gallery, made in 1900.


Although the watercolours are only on show in January (taking full advantage of the northern gloom)

they can actually be viewed 'on request' in other months – with the stipulation that only one request per day will be granted. So if you are planning to make a special pleading you will need to get it in early, or wait till the morrow.

In Aberdeen the Heinzel Gallery is looking forward to showing the work of Robert McAulay in the spring, while the Foyer Gallery has the work of Robbie Bushe on until the end of January.

The Scottish Sculpture Workshop in Lumsden is continuing with its outreach programme, building on last year's 'Lost Hand' programme which aimed to strengthen links between lost skills in the community and the workshop.


