

# Earth, wind and Fruitmarket

DESCRIBED as a selected retrospective of work made from 1996 to the present day, The Fruitmarket Gallery's exhibition presents the art of the internationally renowned artist Jim Lambie.

Glaswegian Lambie, who came to prominence in the late 1990s, was a member of the band The Boy Hairdressers. After his departure to study art they went on to become the highly successful Teenage Fanclub. As well as this Lambie has been a dj for many years so his work is firmly rooted in music and youth culture.

The exhibition is fairly sparse for a retrospective, however, Lambie's trademark piece Zobop (1999-2014) makes

up for this as it entirely covers half the stairway and upper floor of the gallery. It is composed of what is thought of as humble material, that is, multi-coloured vinyl tape. The effect is one of a tripped-out Bridget Riley Op-Art painting, psychedelic, dizzying even.

Before encountering Zobop, the ground floor gallery consists of two pieces, Shaved Ice (2012-14) and a DVD entitled Ultraflow (2007). Shaved Ice is like a forest of brightly coloured ladders in the palette of the DIY store, some are fluorescent and there is still a slight whiff of paint.

The ladders are mirrored between the rungs (and there are a lot of them); this creates a disorientating, kaleidoscopic effect, which is fun and disconcerting at the same time.

However, disconcerting as it may be, Shaved Ice is nothing compared to the DVD Ultraflow and the dangerously dark room in which it is shown (complete with warming). It was noticeable that people were entering and then leaving almost immediately.

This room is very dark, the dvd glows dimly in the distance with pinpoint of light, the lit ends of cigarettes, circulating and hovering in the darkness. The space between the viewer and the screen has the allure of a no-go area yet, weirdly, it resembles a dance floor. The experience is akin to one of being in a dark nightclub wearing dark glasses whilst slightly drunk.

As mentioned, Zobop takes over the upper gallery, which is no bad thing; it gives off a feeling of exuberance and creates a backdrop for the artwork.

Now the viewer is in Zobop world and what they find is a teenage bedroom of dreams circa the mid to late 1970's. For example, a wall of mirrors taken from old dressing tables by the look of them, entitled Perm and Blow Dry (2001), and a wall decorated with the backs of twelve leather jackets which form a circular

shape, Digital (1999). This is echoed in Two Shirts (1996) which, as the name suggests, are two shirts covered in duct tape, one silver and one black, these have been folded and mounted on the wall.

At this point a Saturday Night Fever pitch is starting to materialise. A poster of the disco group Earth, Wind, and Fire helps this along; it has been customised with black paint and hung upside down. Then there is Roadie (1999) a black, glittery record deck with rotating turntable, underneath hangs an array of multicoloured clothes hangers.

Stakka (2000), a floor installation/sculpture of customised vinyl record sleeves adds to the teenage bedroom idea. However, this is not an environment stuck in time. Instead, it comes across as absolutely part of now, the turntable keeps on turning and Lambie is keen to evoke a feeling of perpetual motion.

The idea that it conveys is one of the continuations of culture, that is, even though certain music, clothes and artefacts belong to a past era, they are the building blocks on which the culture of the present and future is based.

At the age of 50 Lambie is showing that when it comes to the particular culture you align with age is irrelevant. A new piece entitled Bluebird (2014) suggests that the ethos apparent in the earlier pieces is still alive and well. A pair of men's black leather Ecco shoes are joined together by a chain of safety pins, one is stuck to the ceiling, the other hovers a few feet from the floor.

There is a collage on the sole of the lower shoe, which shows images of the group The New York Dolls and Lou Reed (the so called god-father of punk).

The connotation of striding out in Ecco shoes (perhaps for the more mature man) with images of icons from another era on the sole delivers a succinct message. It says, our culture lives on well past our youth; we carry it with us on the soles of our shoes.

# An artist who has the time – and inclination – to watch his paint dry

Mary Gladstone talks to Galloway artist William Neal

UNTIL November 2011 Stranraer (in the south-west) was a busy port serving ferries to and from Belfast. But when Stena Line moved three miles up the road to Cairn Ryan, the community began to suffer. However moribund the old harbour town may have become, it is seen by some as an unsung pocket of artistic activity.



"The art scene here," says the artist William Neal, "is very low profile, but undoubtedly there's some real talent around." Neal himself is no slouch. During his career, which spans half a century, he has displayed his paintings in as many as 50 exhibitions. He studied at Guildford School of Art where his tutors, he says, were so dedicated that they "were even prepared to starve for their art."

Nevertheless, after Neal graduated he preferred to earn a wage, so he went into graphics and worked for C.C.S. Associates, a design group in London's West End. There, he met the singer Greg Lake and through him Neal worked for Emerson, Lake and Palmer producing cover designs for albums like 'Tarkus' and 'Pictures at an Exhibition.'

In 1971 Neal abandoned graphics to concentrate on his painting. Seven years later, he met the Polish artist, Stefan Knapp who, as a teenager, was imprisoned by the Soviets in Siberia and later became a Royal Air Force Spitfire pilot.

In the 1970s he created the world's largest mural which was painted on a department store building in New Jersey. Through Knapp's influence as an enamellist, Neal laid the foundations for the work he does today.

"I wanted to develop what Stefan had taught me. That's why I came to Scotland in 1982." Neal began with tranquil landscapes in watercolours. Although he still draws upon the

spectacular countryside around Stranraer as inspiration by his paintings, Neal has adopted lately a looser technique working in abstract with acrylic in iridescent colours.

In applying an 'enamellist's approach' he has achieved something quite new; colours must be applied one at a time, so that some paintings are given as many as 50 glazes.

This means that the finished work achieves a smooth surface, similar to an enamel panel.

Neal admits to having received generous local support, particularly from galleries in the region but he has no illusions about the difficulties facing artists in and around

Stranraer. In among the Galloway hills, fields and bays, are a number of fine artists. Lisa Hooper, a prize-winning artist and printmaker from the seaside village of Port William, creates images of birds and other rural subjects.

Suzan Malcolm from Portpatrick uses bright, uninhibited colours in her still lifes of flowers and birds while Jan Holak from the Stonykirik area paints in various materials and is a fine art photographer; her partner, Mike makes furniture in his own professionally-built, pyramid-shaped studio and gallery. One of the most enterprising projects promised for this neglected area is the renovation

and refurbishment of Stranraer's old grain store in Bridge Street. Built in 1850, the grade B listed building has been on Historic Scotland's at risk list since 2001. Once a coal

yard, a painter's den and a dumping ground, the grain store has survived a number of demolition orders.

It was bought by Richard Leat, an Edinburgh builder and restoration enthusiast interested in theatre and the performing arts.

"I can't see him letting it go!" declares Neal. "It'll take a lot of funding but Stranraer is ripe for this kind of thing."

If he finds the money, Leat will turn part of the building into apartments and construct a multi-purpose performance space with other arts-based facilities for locals, including a music centre and restaurant.

As for the indefatigable William Neal, his paintings are represented by 'Arte in Europa' at the Edinburgh Art Fair on November 13 and 14.

Additionally, this month a sample of his work is featured both on the front cover and within the pages of the publication (now in its 92nd year) of the Dumfries & Galloway Fine Art Society.

As a veteran artist



and speaker, Neal decided to write a book on painting. In 2011 he published *Watching Paint Dry: 50 Years of Painting and the Galloway Landscape*. "Contrary to what many might think, it's not dull watching paint dry. To be good at painting you have to know how it dries!"

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# Going, going, gone... art at auction takes off

Paintings by living Scottish artists are beginning to find a ready sale in Edinburgh and Glasgow auction houses

LOVE HIM or loathe him, it was probably the sale of Jack Vettriano's "The Singing Butler," selling for a (Scottish) record £ 744,800 at Sotheby's in 2004 that opened up the market for contemporary art works. This sale challenged the perception of a deeply conservative attitude among Scotland's art collectors and opened the doors for other living artists.

Typically defined as work by living artists, contemporary art is now considered to be one of the biggest growth areas of the art market.

Charlotte Riordan, painting specialist at the Edinburgh auctioneers Lyon and Turnbull, says: "Contemporary art has been doing exceedingly well internationally over the last few years and, since its recovery post-crash, is widely regarded as the fastest growing area of the art market."

"The Scottish contemporary art market is no exception, though inevitably it is less demonstrative of this trend than London or New York. Nonetheless, Lyon and Turnbull's bi-annual Contemporary and Post War art sales continue to go from strength to strength with good selling rates, competitive prices achieved and increasingly interesting content".

Established in Edinburgh in 1826, Lyon and Turnbull are Scotland's oldest firm of auctioneers and are fast becoming identified on an international stage. They have been hosting dedicated contemporary art auctions since 2006, with sales

continuing to strengthen of both traditional and newer artists.

Ms Riordan says: "John Byrne, though already a staunch favourite among Scottish art collectors in the primary market, has only recently begun to trickle down to the secondary market in any significant way and the group of four oils we sold this month were competitively fought over and collectively fetched over £30,000."

"Additionally, the recent death of John Bellamy has led to the re-emergence of his interesting early output to the market, with an example from 1967 recently selling with us for £49,000."

"We hope to stimulate a stronger culture of collecting both in Scotland and of Scottish artists, and it is exciting that we are seeing the emergence of works by the more recent crop of critically acclaimed Scottish artists, including Nathan Coley, Toby Paterson and Martin Boyce."

Collecting doesn't have to be expensive and the staff at Lyon and Turnbull are keen to encourage a wider audience of collectors.

Ms Riordan adds: "Our sales cater for lower price ranges too, with works starting at around £400, in order to further encourage the next generation of art collectors."

"Contemporary is certainly a good area to begin collecting at auction and we feel passionately that the market needs to keep growing in order to effectively support the careers of Scotland's talented burgeoning artists."

McTear's auction house opened its doors in central Glasgow 170 years ago and buyers from around the world have furnished their homes with the millions of objects that have passed through the auction room doors. Famous and celebrity collectors and enthusiasts, including a young William Burrell, have bid at McTear's, and the company has developed into one of the largest independent auction houses in the UK.

The Scottish Contemporary Art Auctions are staged by McTear's in Glasgow every five weeks

and typically include around 300 paintings which are a mix of pre-owned pictures and those submitted by invited professional artists. These auctions started in 2008 and quickly established McTear's as the single largest sales outlet for Scottish Contemporary paintings.

McTear's pictures specialist, Natasha Raskin, comments: "The company sells more than 2500 pictures a year and the contemporary marketplace has been steady through the recessionary years but is definitely showing solid growth in 2014. Our sales are up over 20% against the

heavily in classic Scottish art, sales in the contemporary art market continue to expand, leading the way for both a new generation of buyers and existing collectors.
