A street artist comes in from the cold – and selfies

Frances Anderson charts the progress of a self taught artist from selling on the street to showing in a top Edinburgh gallery



FROM showing his work on Saturdays on the streets of Edinburgh to the elegant space of The Scottish Gallery, Michael McVeigh presents his first major solo exhibition.

This modern day folk artist is a figurative painter and printmaker who has lived and worked in Edinburgh since 1982. Depicting a romantic vision of Scotland which is both real and imagined, McVeigh creates an almost childlike yet sophisticated setting of both the contemporary and historical life of Scotland.

Focusing on city life, with all its subcultures and traditions, McVeigh portrays Edinburgh streets, Scottish pipes and drums, harbour scenes and pubs, fisherfolk and folk musicians.

Other favourite subjects are the Festival, the Edinburgh Tattoo and Scotland's New Year at Hogmanay.

Born in Dundee, in the post-war council estate of Lochee on the north west of the city, one of five children, McVeigh left school with no formal qualifications; however he wanted to be an artist.

He began, unannounced and uninited, going to classes at Duncan of Jordanstone College of Art, his presence being challenged eventually. James Morrison, then one of the lecturers, eventually formalised his position and accepted him as a full-time student, based solely on his drawings and paintings.

Following this, he did some early paintings as a muralist. Examples can be seen

at Dundee Contemporary Arts, and at a local bowling club in the city. Since then he has lived and worked in Edinburgh, developing his own very personal style of figurative painting and printmaking.

While living in Edinburgh, McVeigh has become a familiar figure, to be seen regularly working in the city and until recently, at his stall on Rose Street selling his 'lizard' prints. 'Lizard' is his spelling of 'laser' – colour copies of his original works, for sale at affordable prices.

Life as a street artist has brought a certain notoriety, especially in recent years, leading to him becoming a cult figure, sought out by the city's many stag and hen parties, and eventually forcing him to limit tourists to a 'one photo only' policy.

His works are held in both public and private collections – including town halls, pubs, fishmongers and a number of municipal and national institutions. McVeigh says: "I didn't really go to school, all I wanted was to be an artist. The only thing I was

ever good at was painting and drawing and everything I have achieved is through that. I try not to think too much about what I'm doing and just do it."

His paintings and prints depict everyday life in Scotland and the Scottish people, but when infused with his own personal perceptions they take on a dreamlike quality, and are rich with poetic imagery.

Working largely from his imagination, the subject of each piece, though rooted in reality, blossoms and grows into something fantastical and full of feeling.

Putting the "X" back in Berwick...

Nick Jones, binoculars in hand once more, goes in search of the elusive X factor in Berwick-upon-Tweed

Whatever happened to the referee?

IN OUR LAST ISSUE we took the BBC to task over its failure to "hold the ring" and referee discussions and debates where opposing views were pitched against one another.

We wrote that the BBC of all bodies should have been confident enough to stand up to possible bullying and state the facts as they demonstrably were.

This had a particular relevance to the EU referendum, where the Leave side in particular were allowed to get away with murdering the facts to support their very tenuous case. ("£350 million a week to spend on new hospitals" - etc.)

There is every likelihood that the BBC caved in to bully-boy tactics from the Leave side – who were certainly not hesitant in crying foul whenever they could.

Now strong confirmation of our case has come from a report commissioned by none other than the BBC Trust itself.

The report, led by former UK national statistician Dame Jill Matheson stated:

Don't just sit there – err, well...

FOR YEARS NOW, ever since computer games arrived and kept many young people glued to their screens, the rise in obesity has been blamed, at least partly, on the inactivity that has followed.

But now, with the arrival of Pokémon Go, young people (as well as the not-so-young) have been encouraged to roam the world as they use the GPS on their smart phones and tablets in the search for 'poke stops' where virtual Pokémon and other items can be collected.

In Scotland, St Mary's Cathedral in Glasgow announced that 'Jesus and Pokémon both found here,' while the Ketchup restaurant (also in Glasgow) was offering Pokémon-themed menus and the Grosvenor cinema has been screening the original 1998 Pokémon film for nostalgic fans.

There is, however, a downside: in Whitburn, West Lothian, £ 8,000 damage was caused by young gamers entering its graveyard in search of monsters, while in Edinburgh, the zoo has been complaining that the presence of Pokémon within its precincts is diminishing the interest in its real, live animals. And the castle introduced a 'gym' where players could battle their Pokémon to gain extra points. But the gamers

still have to pay to get in! However, the fact that playing Pokémon gets people out-and-about may not last. British computer expert, Mark Gore, found a loophole in the game that meant that it was no longer physically necessary to find Pokémon characters.

Lawyers for Pokémon urged him to take his website down to which he supposedly replied, "Gamers can run Pokémon Go for two hours at home and still have the same levels and therefore can take over gyms and compete with others to make it more fun." But, of course, they no longer take exercise.

This summer in Dundee, there has been an alternative to playing Pokémon: following a bucket trail to find 55 different Oor Wullie sculptures (plus a few others, like Michelin man) in celebration of the cartoon figure's 80th birthday.

Variants include a marmalade Wullie, a tartan Wullie and a mechanic Wullie. This is an initiative made by the Archie Foundation, D.C.Thomson and Wild in Art, with its conclusion an auction of the sculptures in aid of the Tayside Children's Hospital, which is raising funds for a new twin-operating theatre surgical suite.

Some credit, finally, where it is due

WELL DONE the National Galleries of Scotland for at last recognising the achievements of our enfant terrible of the arts – Richard Demarco – and giving him the credit he deserves for (amongst many other things) introducing us to Joseph Beuys with the ground-breaking,

(and palindromic) Strategy Get Arts exhibition dating from a time when the Edinburgh Festival really did break new ground.

The exhibition at the Dean Gallery does the subject justice and is well worth a visit. Could this be a sign of livelier things to come?

materialism's craving for instant, total consumption. But that's so passé , so Hollywood, so then and there.

The future? It's Berwick, where artists screen films that muddle and cross borders, hinting at facts and unseen connections beneath the fiction, fleeting images, traces, memories.

Was that a goshawk flying by? Too late now. Gone. After "Search Film" I watched "Writers' Group", by Lucy Parker, artist-filmmaker, in residence in Berwick this summer, jointly supported by BFAF and Berwick Visual Arts.

A group of novice, aspiring writers share new work. It's gripping, tense even. A writer myself, I'm drawn in. So good are Lucy's actors, I don't realise they are acting, and forget that this is a film. I shout out, "Yes, but ..."

Then, I remember. This is just a screen, changing particles of colour and light. When you do get here, you'll notice that Berwick lives, whispering, often shouting its past from every stone.

Duncan's dad is fascinated by goshawks, but has very rarely seen one so, walking the forest, he's looking for signs – a feather, droppings, bones from a recent meal. That's birdwatching! Lots of hope and expectation, not much fulfilment.

very appealing to artists. Yet those traces of pride and independence remain.

Now, the question is, can such steely qualities help it forge a better future? Which is where the Berwick Film and Media Arts Festival comes back into the picture. Lucy's work focuses on links between educational, political and social issues.

She explores how society might do things better, confronting, challenging, unveiling the unseen and unknown. Like "The Home and the World", filmed over two years in a rural care home, which raises fundamental questions about what is meant by a caring society.

In illusioned, Brexit Britain power and influence can seem detached, spinning fiction. Artists see things differently. Here in Berwick, Lucy's new film is inspired by conversations about lobbying and campaign work; and the methods people adopt to involve others with such work.

A radio programme constructed from these interviews creates the sound track. A group travel by bus, arriving in a town and occupying a library, disrupting a children's storytelling session.

Three simple scenes work to poetically illustrate the accompanying voice over. This will have its first screening at the Film Festival.
